



Began 30 years ago by a Mercy religious sister


 Empowering women and children in the colonias along the border

 - Youth Programs






TEXAS COLONIAS

- Colonias first started in the 1950s,
- The colonias lack many critical services (sewage, lights, paved streets, emergency services)
- One-fifth of the 500,000 colonia residents in Texas are children, most of which are US citizens.
- Many families stay in the colonias for generations
 - 61 percent of residents fall below or near the poverty line
 - 55 percent of adults earned less than a high school diploma
 - 45 percent lack English proficiency, as compared to less than 10 percent of residents in the US overall.

Not unusual to receive 600 – 900 people/a day


In April, U.S. Border

- Health inequities caused by uneven distribution of SDOH


