

# **Policy Committee**

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## Charge

- Promote the advancement of timely public health issues and priorities, particularly as they relate to the educational needs of nursing students
  - Represent ACHNE on Nursing Community Coalition (NNC), make recommendations to ACHNE BOD
  - Communicate with key partners (ie: NNC or Quad Council) to discuss policy issues, collaborate and/ take action
  - Write or solicit policy positions on behalf of ACHNE
  - Sponsor policy session at Annual Institute
  - Develop annual policy focus/legislative priorities for ACHNE and recommend to BOD
  - Develop an advocacy tool kit; that promotes policy related to nursing education
  - Develop/review and recommend resources for teaching health policy
  - Initiate social media platform for speed and effectiveness of information distribution
- Work with other ACHNE committees to advance evidence

#### Committee Structure

- Jen Morton is Policy Chair
- Members contribute as needed to complete mutually agreed upon work
- We work as a unified group once consensus is reached
- Meet monthly or more frequently as needed via Zoom
- Still pretty new group, no task forces established yet but you can see the need for involvement!
