Assignment 2: Taking a stance on relevant health issues— a brain based campaign ad

Select a current hot topic that negatively impacts vulnerable populations	Obesity		
Search credible (primary sources) of information for facts related to the issue	CDC Website		
Present a one sentence truthful summary of the concern	Over ½ of adults ages 30-50 are obese		
Identify the major ethical or overall concern of the problem	Obesity costs all people time and money		
Describe the most adversely groups affected by the problem	The most adversely groups affected by obesity are the obese themselves as they have poor life quality and longevity		
State a proposed policy for resolving the issue	Insurance should cover prevention care for adults with obesity whereby they should receive intense emotional and physical support to reduce obesity prevalence		

Half of adults 30-50 years are obese, costing everyone time and money and contributing to poor life quality and longevity. Emotional and physical therapies reduce costs.
