### Criterion:

- **Significance to community health nursing education, research, and/or practice**
  - Of interest to our audience?
  - Implications stated or suggested?
  - If rating for significant is “0” or “1”, the rest of the criteria will be rated a “0”
- **Quality of description of subject matter**
  - Well written and organized?
  - Formatted to include the following sections?
    - Introduction
    - Aims
    - Methods
    - Results
    - Conclusion
  - Style and appearance adequate?
- **Clarity and cohesiveness of abstract**
  - Rationale sound?
  - Conclusions logical?
- **Creativity of approach / Originality of subject**
  - Novelty of concept or application?
- **Relevance to conference theme**
  - AI 2019 Theme: Culture of Health: Equity Thrives on Diversity
  - Addresses at least one of the conference objectives
    - Identify ways to move Healthy People 2030 goals and objectives forward, including community wellbeing.
    - Describe strategies to operationalize the culture of health.
